CONDITIONS

1. The competition will be 18 holes, singles, qualifying, stroke play.
2. The competition is open to junior members of recognised golf clubs, who are aged 17 or under on 1st January of the year played. Playing handicaps under the current Unified Handicapping System of C.O.N.G.U. may not exceed 28 for Boys, 36 for Girls.
3. Completed application forms **must** be accompanied by the entry fee and a stamped addressed envelope.
4. The competition committee reserves the right to refuse entry without having to give a reason.
5. Should entries exceed 72, those with the highest handicaps will ballot for places. Competitors eliminated by ballot will be notified and have their fees returned.
6. Successful applicants will be advised of their tee times on or before 25-Jul-12 Tee times will range from 2:00pm approximately, dependent upon numbers. Lower handicaps will be given earlier time slots where possible.
7. Applicants not notified by 28-Jul-12 should enquire of www.coventrygolfclub.net or phone Coventry Golf Club on 024 7641 4152.
8. In the event of a competitor having to scratch after 25-Jul-12 no entry fees will be refunded.
9. The competition committee reserves the right to fix/alter starting times.
10. Competitors must conform to the Rules of Golf as approved by The Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and the local rules of Coventry Golf Club.
11. Current handicap certificates will be required on the day. Caddies will not be allowed.
12. There will be three divisions determined by age on 1st Jan. year played. Div 1 Under 14. Div 2 aged 14 or 15. Div 3 aged 16 or 17.
13. Boys to play from white tees Girls to play from red tees.
14. Girls will receive 3 additional course adjustment strokes, for competition scoring purposes only.
15. All ties will be decided by the last 9, 6, 3, or 1 holes of the card.
16. The player with the lowest nett score will receive a replica Junior Open Trophy and a prize voucher. In addition vouchers will be awarded for the best overall gross score and the three leading nett and the best gross scores in each division.
17. No competitor may receive more than one prize, they will receive the prize of higher value and remaining prizes will be awarded for the next best scores as appropriate. Players with inactive handicaps are not eligible for prizes.
18. All prize winners are expected to attend the prize giving. Prizes not presented on the day must be collected.
19. All disputes shall be decided by the competition committee whose decision will be final.
20. Coventry Golf Club cannot accept any responsibility for thefts and accidents and competitors must carry their own insurance.
21. Competitors must protect themselves in Health and Safety matters, especially should there be a danger from lightning, when play must stop immediately and not be resumed until the danger has passed.
22. If there is a long blast of a klaxon, play must stop immediately and not be resumed until two short blasts of the klaxon are heard.
23. Competitors must comply with any further conditions advised on the day of competition.
24. Competitors are requested to change from golf clothes following play. Smart casual dress is acceptable.
